Introduction

I. Matters of worship?

A. What or whom are we worshipping?

1. We worship Jehovah God, a jealous God.
 - a. Self described in Scripture six times.
 - i. Exodus 20:5
 - ii. Exodus 34:14
 - iii. Deuteronomy 4:24
 - iv. Deuteronomy 5:9
 - v. Deuteronomy 6:15
 - vi. Joshua 24:19
 - b. He will not compete with any other God
2. The One who saves – John 3:16
3. We must not worship that which man devises – Exodus 32

- B. Worship vs. Service vs. Mass
 - 1. Liturgy – a rite or body of rites prescribed for public worship.
 - 2. Eucharist – What we call the Lord's Supper generally.
 - a. tran/consubstantiation is taught.
 - b. the fruit of the vine is withheld
- C. Where do we worship?
 - 1. Is all of life worship?
 - 2. Is all of church worship?
 - 3. Auditorium vs. Sanctuary
 - a. "Sanctuary" is a term from OT and referenced the
 - b. 137 times, 4 in NT and in reference to OT or Jesus.
 - c. Question here relates to the sanctity of the building.
 - i. Acts 2:46 *"continued daily in the temple and breaking bread from house to house they did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart.."*
 - ii. Romans 16:5 & 1 Corinthians 16:19 Paul sent greetings to the *"church that was in their house."*

II. What occurs in worship.

- A. Types of Music (Colossians 3:16)
 - 1. Psalms (*psallo, psalm*)
 - a. In the early church, this word meant to sing or chant a Psalm.
 - b. May have come from some of the songs of the synagogue.
 - 2. Hymns – Christian melodies
 - 3. Spiritual Songs – Other worshipful music a generic term.

C. Witnessing

1. John the Baptist was a witness to Jesus (John 1:7)
2. Jesus said the Gospel would be preached in all the world as a witness...(Matthew 24:14).
3. A term used by those who would evangelize. Nothing improper provided what we witness is true.
