  - Exodus 23:16
  - Exodus 34:22
  - Numbers 28:26

## Conversion Studies: Pentecost

- **When**
  - 50 days after Passover
  - 1 week after Ascension (Acts 1:3)
- Who
  - First Assembly
  - Begins with power and might
- What
  - Begins a period of painful transition.

## Conversion Studies: Pentecost

- When
  - **Who**
  - What
- Apostles and followers of Jesus (1:12-15)
  - Jews of “every nation” (2:5)
  - At least 15 *languages* represented (2:9-11)
  - “Devout” believers in God. (2:5)

- The fulfillment of ancient prophecies
    - Joel 2:28-32
    - Psalm 16:8-11
    - Acts 2:16-21
    - Acts 2:25-28)
