

Part 2: What is a Christian?

There are a couple of other observations that I should make here. You may consider them negatives, and I guess they are, but they are true.

A Christian is not perfect.

I am perfect twice a day. When I first open my eyes before I even sit up in bed and again in that nanosecond before sleep comes, I am perfect. Otherwise, no. Nope. Not even maybe. The world- and the media feed this nonsense - believes that Christians are perfect and never sin. Sinlessness belongs to Jesus alone.

	"For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus" (Romans 3:22 – 23)
Again,	
	If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (1 John 1:10)

Peter was a sinner (Galatians 2:11 – 14), as was Paul (1 Timothy 1:15). But they, like us, are saved *in spite of* our sins. 1 John 1 speaks of "walking in the light." It is during this time that the blood of Jesus is washing us from our sins. We walk in the light at the same time we sin! Now, our sin must not be deliberate, and we must remain penitent, but we still sin.

A Christian can be a hypocrite.

Another reality is that Christians are often hypocrites. We do the very things we oppose. Hypocrisy is a deadly, often fatal charge against a Christian. No one wants to be a hypocrite, but we often are. Listen to Paul's struggle from Romans 7.

For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing. (Romans 7:18, 19)

The question is not whether we will stumble and thus be guilty of hypocrisy. We will. The real question is why we stumbled. Christians oppose sin as an assault on God's holiness. Yet, Christians, through the weakness of the flesh, still stumble and sin. But, because we depend on the forgiveness of God and practice the same in our lives, we are not hypocrites. We are forgiven.

Should the reader desire to become a Christian they may. But know that in this life you will never be sinless. You will stumble and you will fall. But, in Christ alone, those sins are removed. As Isaiah said, "though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool" (Isaiah 1:18). Leave the way of persistent unforgiven son and some to Christ where all is made new!
